

# PARADE RULES

- Staging is located in the **FRONT** of the Azle ISD Admin Building (300 Roe Street).
- Parade staging starts at 4:30 p.m. Make sure to arrive early enough for your entry to be judged. All judging takes place **BEFORE** the parade.
- Vehicle drivers must hold a valid driver's license and liability insurance, and be at least 21 years old. Azle PD will be checking these documents during check-in.
- Participants must be 18 years or older to ride an ATV, go-cart, or any other recreational motorized vehicle.
- Vehicles must be large enough for all riders to remain seated, with all body parts inside the perimeter of the vehicle.
- Walking parade participants will be allowed to hand out candy or toys during the parade.

**Absolutely no candy or toys shall be thrown from parade vehicles. Violators will not be able to participate in next year's parade.**

- All horse entries must provide Coggins Test papers, waste bags, or a way to pick up any animal waste.
- **NO SANTA OR MRS. CLAUS entries, float riders, etc. We already have a Santa!**
- Late arrivals will be placed at the end of the parade.  
**No Exceptions.**
- Vehicles are not permitted to stop during the parade route.
- ALL entries must have Christmas lights. This parade is at night and we want all to be seen.
- No off-loading of parade participants will be permitted along the parade route.
- The Azle Area Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason.
